ADOPTION OF STREET #127

STATE OF WISCONSIN,
 COUNTY OF POLK,
 TOWN OF MILLTOWN.

Upon the application of 6 or more resident freeholders in the town of Milltown, for adopting a highway, as set forth in the application to us, the undersigned, supervisors of the Town, prepared a notice of the time and place we would meet and decide upon such application and did meet on the 19th day of June, 1993, at one o'clock in the afternoon, at the V. F. W. Hall, that being the time and place stated in the notice; and having first been satisfied by affidavits that the notices required in S. 80.05, had been duly given and published, we did then examine the highway, and did hear all reasons that were offered for and against the application and did decide upon such application; and it being our opinion that the public good will thereby be promoted, did adopt such highway as hereinafter described.

Now, therefore, pursuant to the application, we, the supervisors, do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby adopted in the Town, as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 38 of Certified Survey Map No. 634, Recorded in Volume 3 Certified Survey Map, page 126, Document No. 393758 in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Polk County, Wisconsin; thence North 1°36'15" West 356.95 feet; thence North 17°22'26" West 386.28 feet; thence North 5°16'43" East 770.86 feet; thence North 30°00'59" East 257.13 feet; thence along the arc of a cul-de-sac 307.10 feet, whose chord bears South 59°59'01" East 66 feet; thence South 30°00'59" West 242.66 feet; thence South 05°16'43" West 743.17 feet; thence South 17°22'26" East 375.29 feet; thence South 01°36'15" East 389.95 feet; thence North 76°34'16" West 66.37 feet to the point of beginning.

A parcel of land, being an access road, located in Government Lot Four (4), and the East Half of the Southwest Quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 36 Township 35 North, Range 17 West, Town of Milltown Polk County, Wisconsin, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a 1" X 24" iron pipe at the Southeast corner of Lot 6 of Certified Survey Map No. 399, as recorded in Volume 2, page 128 in the Polk County Register of Deeds office; thence North 07°10'31" East 670.03 feet along the Westerly right of way of said access road to a 1"X24" iron pipe and the South line of a town road; thence, leaving said Westerly right of way, South 76°34'16" East 66.40 feet to a 1"X24" iron pipe and the Easterly right of way of said access road; thence South 07°10'31" West 655.70 feet, along Easterly right of way to a 1"X24" iron pipe; thence, leaving said Easterly right of way, North 88°57'43" West 66.37 feet to a 1"X24" iron pipe at the Point of Beginning of this description, Polk County, Wisconsin.

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The line described is the center of the highway, and the same is laid out of the width of four (4) rods.

THEREFORE, the Town Board, Town of Milltown, at there monthly meeting held the 12th day of July, 1993, voted by a vote of 3 to 0, to adopt the application for the road, to be known as 127th Street.
