

**Resolution # 00-02  
Town of Milltown  
Polk County, Wisconsin**

A Resolution adopting a Public Participation Plan for the development of a Comprehensive Plan:

WHEREAS, the town of Milltown will develop a comprehensive plan as defined in section 66.0295 (2) of the Wisconsin Statutes to guide community actions and to promote more informed land use decisions.

WHEREAS, pursuant to sections 60.22(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes the town of Milltown is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in sections 66.0295 (1) and 66.0295 (2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 66.0295 (4) (a) of the Wisconsin Statutes the governing body of a local governmental unit shall adopt written procedures that are designed to foster public participation, including open discussion, communication programs, information services and public meetings for which advance notice has been provided, in every stage of the preparation of a comprehensive plan.

WHEREAS, the written procedures pursuant to section 66.0295 (4) (a) of the Wisconsin Statutes must also provide for a wide distribution of proposed drafts, alternatives, and amendments of the comprehensive plan and shall provide an opportunity for written comments on the plan to be submitted by members of the public to the governing body and for the governing body to respond to such comments.

WHEREAS, the town of Milltown has already taken substantial steps to confirm that planning is needed, to gather community input on issues and desired outcomes, and to inform and educate the community on planning.

WHEREAS, the town of Milltown will continue to build upon and integrate prior public participation efforts to develop a comprehensive plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board of Milltown, Polk County, Wisconsin, in order to continue to promote public participation in local planning efforts and development of a comprehensive plan hereby adopts the attached Milltown Public Participation Plan to foster public participation throughout the plan development process; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the public participation plan represents the core efforts to be used by the town of Milltown for development of a comprehensive plan, although additional public participation efforts may occur.
