ORDINANCE NO. 18

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Milltown, Polk County, Wisconsin, with the Board of Education of the Unity School District, deems it necessary to have these following rules governing the use of motor vehicles on or around the Unity School property:

- 1. LOUD AND UNNECESSARY NOISE PROHIBITED: No person shall make or cause to be made any loud, disturbing or unnecessary sounds or noises such as may tend to disturb or annoy a person of ordinary sensibilities in or about any public street, alley, park, school property or any private residence.
- 2. OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES: No person shall operate a motor vehicle so as to cause the tires thereof to squeal, the horn to blow excessively, or the motor to race excessively.
- 3. ALL POSTED SPEED LIMITS SHALL BE OBSERVED: No person shall operate a motor vehicle in a speed in excess of ten (10) miles per hour on the Unity School property.

Any person who violates this ordinance shall be required to forfeit a sum of not more than \$200.00 together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof may be confined to the Polk County Jail until said forfeiture and costs are paid but not to exceed 90 days.

WHEREAS, the law enforcement of the Town of Milltown is under the Polk County Sheriff Department any violators will be prosecuted under the laws of the State of Wisconsin according to the Wisconsin Statutes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Milltown adopts this ordinance on motor vehicles use on Unity School property.
