RESOLUTION #27

WHEREAS; the district is necessary to define the present and anticipated problems of Antler Lake and to identify their causes and to implement various remedial measures to deal with the problems and to undertake activities such as protection of the fishery, maintenance of appropriate lake levels, control of aquatic weeds and reduction of sedimentation.

WHEREAS: the public health, comfort, convenience, necessity or public welfare will be promoted by the establishment of the district.

WHEREAS: the district will not contribute to long-term environmental pollution.

AND WHEREAS: the lands included within the district will be benefitted by the district, which includes all lakeshore properties including lots with lake access as well as adjoining properties listed on the legal description. The boundaries of the land are shown on an attached sketch indicating the approximate area and boundaries of the district and an attached list of the legal descriptions of all property owners of the district.

- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Town Board of the
- Town of Milltown, Polk County, Wisconsin, declare that the Antler Lake Association be establish under Wisconsin Statutes Chapter 33 Subchapter IV for the protection and rehabilitation of public inland lakes.
