Requesting Lake Management Planning Grant
Town of Milltown, Polk County, Wisconsin

WHEREAS inland lakes within the Town of Milltown are an important resource used by the public for recreation and enjoyment of natural beauty; and

WHEREAS a study and examination of the lakes and the surrounding land uses will lead to better understanding and will promote the public health, comfort, convenience, necessity and public welfare; and

WHEREAS we recognize the need for responsible and holistic long-range planning to better manage the lakes, watershed(s), and their use; and

WHEREAS we are qualified to carry out the responsibilities of this planning project

IT IS, THEREFORE, RESOLVED THAT:

The Town of Milltown requests the funds and assistance available from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources under the "Lake Planning Project Grant Program; and

HEREBY AUTHORIZES the Town Board to act on behalf of the Town of Milltown to submit an application to the State of Wisconsin for financial aid for lake planning purposes; sign documents; and take necessary action to undertake, direct, and complete approved planning grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Town of Milltown will meet the obligations of the planning project including timely publication of the results and meet the financial obligations under this grant including the prompt payment of our 25% cash commitment to planning project costs.

We understand the importance of a continuing management program for our inland lakes and intend to proceed on that course.
