# TOWN OF MILLTOWN, POLK COUNTY, WISCONSIN

## Resolution of Town Board to Propose Exceeding Levy Limits

**Resolution Number: 23-1** 

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has adopted levy limits on town, village, city and county levies for 2018 and thereafter under s. 66.0602 of Wis. Statutes;

Whereas, s. 66.0602 of Wis. Statutes limits the allowable local levy for 2023 to a percentage increase of no more than the greater of a percentage equal to the percent change in equalized value due to net new construction; which for the Town of Milltown is .635% percent:

Whereas, the Town Board of the Town of Milltown. Polk County believes that for the 2023 tax levy (collected in 2024) it is in the town's best interest to exceed the state levy limit as described above by a greater percentage than 0%.

Whereas, the Town of Milltown 2023 payable 2024 adjusted actual levy is \$738,500; And further whereas the state law would limit the increase to dollar amount allowed for net new construction for an allowable town tax levy of \$629,818 before adjustments, for 2023, collected in 2024.

Now Therefore the Town Board of the Town of Milltown, Polk County does hereby resolve and order as follows:

- 1. The town board supports an increase in the town tax levy for 2023 that will exceed the state levy limit.
- 2. The town board directs that the question of increasing the allowable town tax levy for 2023 (to be collected in 2024) by 17.2%, which would increase the allowable town levy by \$ 108.682 (the amount for Debt Service and Interest) for a total town tax levy of \$738.500 shall be placed on the agenda for the special town meeting to be held on October 23,2023.

This is because the special town elector meeting must be noticed at least 15 and not more than 20 days in advance pursuant to s. 60.12. Wis. Stat.
