PARKING ON LISTED HIGHWAYS/TOWN ROADS
ORDINANCE NO. 25-1

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF MILLTOWN DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

This ordinance, adopted by most of the Town Board of the Town of Milltown on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on highways in the town as follows:

SECTION I - PURPOSE

Safety for the traveling public on Highways/Town Roads is a main concern of the Town of Milltown. In addition, it is the Town of Milltown's desire to allow citizens access to public waters within the Town of Milltown utilizing those public accesses which do not have parking areas but rather utilize the Right of Way of highways/town roads in the Town of Milltown.

SECTION II - AUTHORITY

The Town Board of the Town of Milltown, Polk County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 346 (1)(b) and [349.13](#), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance which grants general police powers to regulate certain uses, activities, and operations that may affect the highways/town roads in the Town of Milltown.

SECTION III - DEFINITIONS

Authorized Official - Town Board Members, Town Clerk, and Head of Road Maintenance.

Highway - means all public ways and thoroughfares and bridges on the same. It includes the entire width between the boundary lines of every way open to the use of the public as a matter of right for the purposes of vehicular travel.

Public Access - Access to a public lake or waterway from a town road owned and maintained by the Town of Milltown.

Road Right-of-Way - (RoW) A maximum of thirty-three (33) feet from the centerline of a town road on either side.

Town Road-A Road that is maintained by the Town of Milltown.

SECTION IV - JURISDICTION

This ordinance shall apply to all Highways/Town Roads listed in the Town of Milltown in Section V (A) below. The Town of Milltown Board grants jurisdiction and the power to enforce this ordinance to the Polk County Sheriff's Department and any Authorized Official of the Town of Milltown Board.

SECTION V – LISTED ROADWAY PARKING RESTRICTIONS

A. The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on the following Highways/Town Roads in the Town of Milltown is subject to the following restrictions and limitations:

Parking shall be limited to the **South Side only** of 190th Avenue between the “Parking This Side of Road Only” signs which are posted between Fire Numbers 1241 and 1234. Parking on the **North Side** of 190th Avenue in that location is prohibited by this ordinance as posted with “No Parking This Side of Road”.

B. Authorized Officials for the Town of Milltown shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described road on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

C. No persons may operate any vehicle on the above-noted Highways/Town Road(s) in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing, or parking restrictions and limitations. Any violation shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$100.00.

SECTION VI. SEVERABILITY

If any section, phrase, sentence, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portions shall be deemed separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Town of Milltown inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby superseded.

This ordinance is effective on publication on December 15th, 2025.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. [60.80](#), Wis. stats.
